IRONMAN 70.3 Turkey


Belek is the most recent host for IRONMAN, which takes place in more than 92 cities worldwide amid enormous excitement!






Aspendos

A fter passing the city of Serik on the Antalya-Alanya highway and about 17 km from Belek, you will encounter a turn to the north of 4 km, to Aspendos. Built in the 2nd century, the Aspendos can accommodate an audience of up to 17,000 people and is one of the rare theatres that remained intact to the present time, together with its stage.

The secret of the theatre's perfect acoustics, as designed by the young Xenon, remain a mystery. The Selçuks used Aspendos as a caravanserai in the 13th century, and improved the north part of the city with an arch typifying Selçuk architecture.

These days, the Aspendos theatre is still used for concerts, festivals and events, including traditional Turkish oil wrestling. The Agora, Basilica, Nymphaeum, and the arched waterways approximately 15 km away, are well worth a visit.







Perge

Perge was established 18 km from Antalya on the east side, between the Düden and Aksu rivers. On the highway to Alanya, turn north at Aksu city and continue for about 2 km to Perge. It is approximately 22 km from Belek.

Due to its distance from the sea, Perge remained safe from pirate attacks and its development continued unhindered.

Established in 1200 BC, Perge signed a pact with Alexander the Great in 334 AD. Like a similar one with Side, this accord spared Perge from war and potential destruction. Thus, the region continued to thrive throughout the Hellenic, Roman and Byzantine eras.

Built in the 11th century, the Perge theatre has a capacity of around 15,000 people, while the adjacent stadium can accommodate 12,000. The Perge stadium, along with the Aphrodisas stadium in the Aegean region, is considered among the best-built stadiums of that era. Under the tiered stadium seating are 30 rooms which were thought to be used as shops.

In the last years, numerous statues and works of art have been excavated. The city gates, the Agora, Nymphaeum, the pillared streets, sarcophagi, Basilica and Acropolis of Perge are all notable sites.













Sillion

On the northeast side of Perge and 12 km from the sea, Sillion is built in the middle of a plain on a high, flat hill. It lies at the end of a 13km-long gravel road at the 29th km of the Antalya-Alanya highway going north. Sillion is approximately 15 km from Belek.

It is believed that the city was established following the Trojan War.

Sillion was the centre of the episcopacy in both the Byzantine and Selçuk periods.

The west of the gently sloping hill is surrounded by walls from the Hellenistic era and the tower, doors and streets leading up to the city complete these walls.

A climb up the hill offers views of the ruins of houses and cistern on the northwest

On the southwest skirt of the hill, you will find a theatre for 8,000 people and, next to it, the Odeon.

Kurşunlu Waterfalls

East of the centre of Antalya and on the way to Alanya, turn at the 24th km to Isparta. After 7 km you will arrive at the Kurşunlu Waterfalls.

These waterfalls, set in a deep green fairytale-like valley, are among the most-visited natural wonders in the area. The entire site can be toured on foot in around 30 minutes. In addition, several varieties of fish live in the water, and rich vegetation blankets the area. The Düden Waterfalls and the Manavgat Waterfalls are also well-known, and often used for location shots in Turkish films.

Köprülü Canyon

 Coprüçay river, born in the Taurus Mountains, passes

 through canyons that are nature's wonders and

pours into the Mediterranean south of the Serik. Fed by the underground streams in the steep-sided canyons, the Köprüçay river is one of the most beautiful sites in Turkey.

In addition to the canyon, you can find the city of Selge (Zerk) in this mountainous terrain, with castles on the river banks, along with aqueducts and bridges from the Roman era, as well as archaeological treasures such as the historical streets.



Selge

The mountain city of Selge, just next to the Köprüçay river, can be reached after the "Köprülü Canyon Milli Park" via a steep, curvy, ancient 14km-long road. It is believed that Selge was founded by the prophet Kalehes. The region belonging to Pisidia was later included within the border of Pamphylia. Over time, the city was under the control of the Lydian, Persian, Alexandrian and Roman states. The remains of the city include a theatre in the cliffs; on the south side, you can find a stadium and a gymnasium, while on the west lies an ornate, lonic-style temple with an eagle motif. There is a foundation and an by the extending walls, you can find the monuments of Artemis and Zeus located in a necropolis in the north.

Rapid urbanization and environmental pollution has driven humans to an even greater consideration for mental and physical health during vacations. With its living fauna, wide variety of vegetation and animal species, and an ideal climate, Belek's stature among similarly rare destinations is rising.

Belek is a pure miracle of eco-tourism with its natural features and modern facilities. The habitats provided by golf courses to nature and animals, and the sensitivity of BETUYAB and the local administrations leave our guests with a strong sense of untrammelled nature and its exuberant chorus.

Belek provides an optimal research area for the science of ornithology (bird watching), as many birds spend the winter here and also reproduce.

BETUYAB is natural supporter of all examinations and classifications of bird species. You may find yourself becoming serene as you listen to the joyousness reflected in the sweet sounds of nature...











n European general flora, there are 12,000 plant species. In our country, this number is 9,500.

This gratifying ratio increases when endemic plants are considered. Endemic plants are plants that grow naturally and solely in specific areas worldwide

Their ecological and physiological behaviours are mostly unique, and this transforms Belek into a biological heritage that belongs to all humanity.

From 600 endemic plants (solely growing in specific areas worldwide) in the Mediterranean Area, 500 variants exist in the environment of Antalya. Botanical studies reveal that more than 118 valuable plants can be found in Belek. And 200 variants exist solely in Antalya.

BETUYAB's studies on global tourism trends indicate the role that environmental awareness plays on consumers' choices and the importance of a tourism approach that respects the environment.

To further express its awareness, BETUYAB prepared the "Belek Coast Plan" together with the World Bank's Wildlife Conservation Society and relevant public institutions; and consistently demonstrates an approach that respects nature while continuing to safeguard this precious heritage.

Caretta Caretta

One of the ancient world's most treasured gifts is the Caretta Carettas. Inspiring humanity, these delightful sea turtles are dispersed throughout the Mediterranean coast. The most important nesting areas are Belek, Adana, Anamur, Köyceğiz and Dalyan Beach. The Belek coast is the largest nesting area in the Mediterranean. Around 2,500 nests were found and taken under protection in 2016. The turtles' shells can grow to up to 1 m. They feed on fish, crustaceans and other water creatures, especially jellyfish.

It is believed that these turtles have existed for around 106 million years.

Due to intensive residential and light pollution on the beaches today, the Caretta Carettas' numbers have gradually declined. With their silent character, the Caretta Carettas bestow upon human watchers a feeling of peace. The turtles' living area is a miraculous paradise; they are happy in Belek.
